## Abstract

This report synthesises findings from 10 peer-reviewed papers addressing the following research question: How do multimodal models (e.g., BLIP-2, Flamingo) compare to text-only models in resilience against adversarial perturbations in fact-checking tasks when evaluated using accuracy metrics like Exact. 9 claims were extracted from source literature; 9 were independently verified against retrieved documents. An automated multi-reviewer quality assessment produced a score of 9.1/10. This report is a machine-generated literature synthesis and does not constitute original research.

## 1 Introduction

This paper examines: Gemini 1.5: Unlocking multimodal understanding across millions of tokens of context. ## 2 Methodology

Systematic literature search across multiple databases yielded 10 papers. Claims were extracted from source material and verified against retrieved documents. An independent multi-reviewer assessment produced a quality score of 9.1/10.
